LENTEN STATIONS OF THE CROSS On Fridays during Lent, after morning Mass, the Celebrant will lead the Stations of the Cross.




LENTEN SHARELIFE APPEAL

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS UPDATE Effective March 21, 2022

Mask wearing indoors will no longer be mandatory. You are most welcome to continue wearing a mask if it makes you more comfortable.

Please continue sanitising upon church entry. Please also continue to self-monitor for symptoms and stay home from church if you are experiencing symptoms. Thankyou!

Starting on March 21, individuals aged 18 and older, who have received their Covid-19 booster shot and who are *asymptomatic for Covid,* do not need to self-isolate when they are in close contact with someone who tests positive for Covid-19 (including if the sick person is a member of their household). The self-isolations requirement is also lifted for those younger than 18 years old who are asymptomatic and who have had two Covid-19 vaccine doses. If you meet these criteria, for 10 days you must wear a mask in public, refrain from elective visits to medical settings and avoid physical contact with those who are vulnerable to Covid. Those who do not meet the above criteria and who have a Covid-19 close contact, must continue to self-isolate according to current provincial regulation.

HUMANITARIAN RELIEF FOR UKRAINE

The Archdiocese of Toronto has launched a humanitarian relief effort to help the Ukrainian people at this time. The Archdiocese of Toronto will channel donations to support the *Office for Refugees, Archdiocese of Toronto (ORAT) and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA)*. CNEWA is a papal agency currently working in Eastern Europe, providing Ukrainians with food, shelter, medicine and transportation to safe locations. ORAT will use donations to bring Ukrainian refugees to Canada as soon as possible.
