REGISTRATION DEADLINE! FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMMES 2021-2022

Registration for the Sacramental preparation programmes is ongoing. There is plenty of space available at this time.

The DEADLINE to register is: WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2021

We invite St. Cecilia parish families with children currently in grade 2 (or higher) who wish to receive First Communion and parishioner families with children currently in grades 7 or 8 who wish to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, to register for our programmes.

Students who attend our 2 parish schools are also invited to register.

Please note that due to the limits on our registration space, priority will be given to families who live within our parish boundary or who are registered formally as parishioners. Remaining spaces will be allotted in the order in which the registrations are received.

Programme registration forms are available from an usher at Mass and are posted under the Sacraments tab on the parish website: saintcecilia.ca

We will not be holding an in-person registration evening.

To register, please submit the following 3 items *TOGETHER* to the
PARISH OFFICE on or before November 17, 2021:

- 1. The Registration Form
- 2. A copy of your child's Baptism Certificate (if not St. Cecilia Parish)
- **3.** The programme registration fee of \$35.00 (cash or cheque ONLY. Please make cheques payable to: *St. Cecilia Church*)

Please mail or drop off the 3 requirements *TOGETHER* to the parish office located at **the** *HOUSE* at **161 Annette Street**.

The mail slot is at the bottom of the front door of the **HOUSE**.

Please PRINT CLEARLY - thank-you!

If we don't receive a legible e-mail address, you cannot be registered.

If you do not submit the 3 requirements together, you will not be registered.

If the fee is a barrier, please contact the office.

Each programme consists of approximately 8 sessions. There will be recorded video sessions presented in conjunction with weekly "live" virtual parish sessions. You will have *some* flexibility with scheduling your viewing of the recorded sessions. The accompanying mandatory parish sessions will not be recorded and will be held on Tuesday evenings for Confirmation and Wednesday evenings for First Communion. Once registration closes, registrants will receive an email with specific programme information from the catechists.


