#### Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops

Each week, beginning Sunday, 21 November 2021, the CCCB will release a video recording of a Bishop reflecting on the Gospel Reading for each Sunday of Advent.

This year's reflections were inspired by Indigenous Delegation travelling to Rome to meet with Pope Francis December 17-20, 2021. Each reflection is based one of the five essential stages of reconciliation: examen, confession, repentance, reparation (making amends), and reconciliation.
