#### APOLOGY BY THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF CANADA TO THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLES OF THIS LAND

The Catholic Bishops of Canada, gathered in Plenary last week, took the opportunity to affirm and acknowledge to the Indigenous Peoples the suffering experienced in Canada's Indian Residential Schools. Along with those Catholic entities which were directly involved in the operation of the schools and which have already offered their own heartfelt apologies (1), we (2), the Catholic Bishops of Canada, express our profound remorse and apologize unequivocally."
