Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion A Message from Fr. Rob...

Our journey through Lent has been one of prayerfully reflecting on the Gospels and the gift of mercy that comes to us from God. Conversion is an essential aspect of discipleship. Knowing that we are loved and forgiven inspires us to keep persevering in faith and trust.

We are invited to walk with the Lord through the events of Holy Week and the Lord's Paschal Mystery. The liturgies are moments for us to grow in holiness once again.

We have two opportunities to gather together as a Family of Parishes. The first is on Holy Thursday when we reflect on the gift of the Eucharist. How powerful this liturgy is as we welcome the holy oils used in the sacraments and listen to the Lord's invitation to serve one another in love. We are privileged to share in the banquet of Christ's sacrifice, knowing that this gift is what defines us. We are centred in the Eucharist. We will gather all together on Thursday at 7 pm at St. John Vianney Church. Following the liturgy we will have time of silent prayer together before the Blessed Sacrament.

On Holy Saturday, we will gather at Our Lady of the Atonement for the Easter Vigil at 7 pm. Listening to scripture, blessing the waters of baptism and welcoming new members into the community will reinforce who we are as disciples centred in the Risen Christ. May these days be filled with grace for all of us as we pray with and for one another.
