Sunday, April 14, 2024 Third Sunday of Easter

Again we are invited to reflect on the presence of the Risen Lord. This time we are treated to a lesson in evangelization. The two disciples share their experience of encountering the Risen Lord on the Road to Emmaus. They are filled with joy and they want the other disciples to share in that joy. Then Jesus appears and confirms their witness story.

Our task as witnesses of the Risen Lord is to radiate the joy of knowing Jesus and sharing that joy with others. To be a witness of the Resurrection flows from our baptism. It is an essential component of who we are in the world today. Think of moments in your life when you have encountered Jesus. How did this make you feel? Did anything change for you at that moment? Did you share the joy of this experience with anyone?

Pope Francis is calling all of us to be missionary disciples, fully embracing the Gospel and sharing it with joy. I plan to re-read the Pope's document on the Joy of the Gospel while on retreat this week.
