We met with our 3 contacts from the homes and are working on a process to get back for mass in May. In order to do this, we want to have a meeting with those interested in serving as volunteers and go over some of the protocols that are constantly changing so we will review them at the meeting. Please mark your calendars and plan to join us for this important training session on Thursday, April 20th at 1 pm in St. Francis Hall at Our Lady of the Atonement church. Robin (ext. 21) can assist you with the process required to obtain a Police Check. In many cases because of the time period, many of the records will have expired and a new records check will be required. Due to some of the nursing home protocols we will not require as many volunteers present per mass so this will be a great help to us as many of our volunteers are no longer able to assist.
