Sunday, April 21, 2024 Fourth Sunday of Easter

Today is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday. Our primary vocation, as a result of our baptism is to be a disciple of Jesus. Everything else flows from this fact. Being a follower of Jesus means that each of us discerns how we are going to best serve the Lord, using the abundance of gifts we have been given to proclaim the Good News. As we celebrated Easter masses recently with our school children, we reflected on the task that is ours to live in the Light of Christ and to share that Light each day.


