Sunday, April 23, 2023 Third Sunday of Easter A Message from Fr. Rob

On this 3rd Sunday of Easter we hear of how the Risen Lord walks with us on our journey. The disciples walking to Emmaus had lost hope, their faces downcast and their hearts heavy with confusion and grief. Into this experience of sadness comes the Lord who offers to walk with them and as they walk, He begins to share with them God's plan of salvation. It is only when they get to the inn and sit at table and the Lord breaks the bread that they recognize Him.

This weekend we welcome the first group of children who will receive the Eucharist for the first time. In the breaking of the bread, the Risen Jesus comes to all of us to nourish us and restore our hope. May we always treasure this gift of the Eucharist. When we come to mass, may we open our eyes and our hearts to experience the Risen Lord.

It is in the breaking of the bread that we become one in mind and heart and begin to resemble the early Christian community spoken of in the Acts of the Apostles

The children will be receiving the Eucharist for the first time on the weekends of April 29/30 and May 6/7 at the weekend masses. Let us continue to keep them in our prayers.


BINGO VOLUNTEERS- Our Lady of the Atonement
