Sunday, December 3, 2023 First Sunday of Advent A Message from Fr. Rob

Come Lord Jesus, Come! This is our Advent prayer for the next four weeks. I invite you to pray these simple words throughout the day. It disposes us to live in the present moment, opening our hearts to God's presence each day. The Saints teach us to keep our eyes open and to stay alert as we prepare for the Lord's coming. As we wait, we serve our sisters and brothers. We are those servants entrusted with many tasks as we await the Master's return. This season always helps us to appreciate the value of waiting. Add to it moments of silence which strengthen us to face the many challenges of our day by quietly appreciating the grace God sends our way.

As a Family of Parishes we continue to face many challenges as we seek to best share the Gospel. The insert today (2 sided) is a report from our Finance Committee, outlining our status from June to the end of October. We have also provided the attendance data to give us a glimpse of how we are recovering from COVID. It has been and remains challenging. We have some financial hurdles to overcome and we all need to get better at evangelizing our friends and neighbours and share the good news of being part of a parish community.

Two of our parishes experienced a deficit during this period. St. Anthony due to the continued pause in Sunday liturgy as we work out some arrangements with the Diocese and the parish community. St. John Vianney has struggled with getting people back to regular worship and offertory giving. Even the addition of the 11 am mass has not provided the result we were hoping for and we will need to seriously discern a way forward that best utilizes our resources. We just received a bequest of \$17000 for SJV which will greatly help towards decreasing the deficit and we are hopeful things are moving in the right direction.
