Prepare the Way of the Lord Second Sunday of Advent December 5, 2021 A Message From Fr. Jim....

Imagine being one of those shepherds privileged enough to hear the angel's announcement of the birth of the Lord: "Today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord". You might be terrified at the sight of the angel, but his words are filled with such promise that you can't help but rejoice in the news: the long-awaited Messiah has finally been born! Your salvation is at hand!

On this second Sunday of Advent we are reminded that the Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy. John the Baptist is the figure in our Gospel this weekend and how he was one who prepared the way of the Lord. When I first saw the musical play, Godspell, I was spellbound by the opening piece of music, "Prepare Ye". The trumpet announced the beginning of the song and then the voice of the Baptist sang this music. Haunting and wonderful. It called every person who heard it to take seriously that it was our responsibility to get ready to welcome the One who is to come.

Over and over again we are exhorted to make the way ready for the Word to be alive in our midst. As our Church signs say – We are all Innkeepers who decide if there is room for Jesus. Make this a reality and make room for him.

The crèche (Nativity) has been set up at both Our Lady of the Atonement and St. John Vianney. As has been done in the past there will be a blessing and lighting of the Nativity on Tuesday, December 7th, at 6:30 pm.
