Sunday, February 18, 2024 First Sunday of Lent

"Repent and believe in the good news." With these words Jesus proclaims that the Kingdom of God is here. As we listen to these words ourselves, two things are required of us as we begin this journey, two actions which will define how successful our conversion is going to be! First, we hear the word "repent". This means that we must change. Change our hearts, attitudes, behaviour, sinful ways. Repent means a complete and total change relying on God's grace to allow this to happen. That means we must pray for openness and flexibility to allow the Lord to work in our lives. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be an important tool to help us with this part of the journey.

Secondly, we must believe. Believe in God's promises to be our strength. Believe in God's unconditional love shown to us in the ministry of Jesus. Believe that anything and everything is possible if we truly allow God into our lives. This is the heart of conversion and it begins today and we are given these 40 days to immerse ourselves in the experience of God's love and grace.

Through prayer, fasting and works of mercy our Lenten journey will be filled opportunities to grow in discipleship. How will we listen to the good news proclaimed to us this Lent?


LITURGICAL UPDATES
