February 20, 2022 Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time A Message From Fr. Rob...

The Gospel this weekend continues Jesus' discourse to the crowds "on the plain" - one significant difference from Matthew's version of the Beatitudes where Jesus went up the mountain. Jesus is putting into concrete terms His expectations for those who choose to follow Him and aspire to live the Gospel each day. It is a demanding job description to be sure. Jesus invites us not to be satisfied with just the bare minimum. He pushes us further. He lays out what we know as the Golden Rule: do to others as you would have them do to you. This is one of the pillars of the Christian moral life. We are to act always out of love, remembering in our interactions with one another the call to love and respect each person.

This week is exciting in our family of Parishes as we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with our youth. It has been challenging to prepare them and I am grateful for all those involved in helping them prepare. Confirmation is a special gift that enables each disciple to be renewed by the power of the Holy Spirit and to dig deep to use wisely the gifts given to us in baptism. These celebrations are always moments of grace for us as we witness these young people make a commitment to follow the Lord more closely. May the Lord bless our youth this week.
