Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus continues His Sermon on the Plain this weekend. Having spoken about the Beatitudes and the kind of spirituality Jesus expects from all disciples, He now turns to helping them to make practical applications to their life experience. To be a person of the Beatitudes means living in a completely different way. Jesus demands we go further. He is pushing the boundaries for us, asking us to expand our vision and our understanding of what is possible when we strive to live a life of grace.

Luke's Gospel calls us to a life focussed on justice, peace, forgiveness and the radical choice to love always. Are we prepared to embrace this way of living? Of course we are. We have the Holy Spirit as our Leader and Guide to help us.

We are quickly approaching the Lenten Season. Take advantage of the prayer materials available in St. Francis Hall and determine now what your Lenten practices will involve.
