From the accounting department....

Please **DO NOT** use 2019 envelopes anymore. Throw them into recycling. Many numbers have changed for 2020 so please help us keep our accounting accurate. Please consider putting your name and address on the envelope each week. We are required to keep them by law and it makes it easier if there are any corrections to be made.

If you have any questions about your donations, envelopes, PAR, have an address change etc. please speak to Pauline. We are busy preparing the year-end reports and getting the tax receipts ready for distribution. Please note that CRA allows us to the end of February. We are still processing the last of 2019 envelopes. We do them in batches and it takes time to prepare them all. We will advise when they are ready to be picked up after masses to save on cost of postage. Thank you.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

The anointing of the sick continues the healing ministry of Jesus. We pray for those sick in mind, body or spirit, those preparing for surgery or undergoing treatment or those weakened under the burden of years. In the parishes, we celebrate communally twice a year. At other times, speak to one of the priests after mass and we will be happy to celebrate this sacrament with you. This powerful sacrament reminds us that Jesus came to heal and help those who are weary.

There is a common misconception that we still celebrate "Last Rites" This is not so. We have prayers called Commendation of the Dying when possible.

The hospitals have one Catholic Chaplain split between 3 sites. The other priests of the city take turns providing on-call pastoral care when their pastoral duties allow. Sometimes it is just not possible. There are some days, due to the shortage of priests that do not have coverage. This is the norm these days. We try our best but we cannot be everywhere. When a loved one is hospitalized, ask the nursing staff to contact spiritual care or the on-call chaplain.

We must trust in God's loving mercy and compassion for the dying and families are encouraged in these situations to pray together, surrounding their loved ones with prayers and blessings. DR. DOMENICO PAONESSA
