Our readings continue the theme of being called to discipleship. The Prophet Jonah is sent by God to proclaim an important message to the people of Nineveh. It took a couple of tries but Jonah finally overcame his reluctance and obeyed the Lord's command to go and preach God's message. In the Gospel Jesus encounters a group of fisherman and simply calls them to follow Him, leaving behind their boats and nets and fish and start a new life.

All of us have been called to follow Jesus. On the day of our baptism we became a disciple and our life in Christ began. From that moment we are invited to keep our eyes on the Lord and listen attentively to His word. As we listen to the scriptures this weekend, the Sunday of the Word of God, what do we hear the Lord saying to us? And what will be our response to this invitation?
