Sunday, January 22, 2023 Third Sunday in Ordinary Time A message from Fr. Rob....

We hear in the Gospel today how Jesus, the Word of God Made Flesh meets the fishermen and changes their lives with a simple invitation: "Come, Follow Me!" What a dramatic change for them indeed as they leave behind their boats and nets to follow Jesus. On this Sunday of the Word of God, we are invited to think about the invitation we have received to follow Jesus. Like those fishermen, we are invited to change our lives and allow the Word-Jesus to transform us into intentional disciples who are enthusiastic to bring God's love to the world.

Each day we can turn to the scriptures for comfort, consolation, inspiration, encouragement, guidance. Why not set time aside each day and open yourself to the power of God's Word?


There is a Time for Everything under Heaven...


