The Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord is a wonderful continuing celebration of Christmas. St. Matthew recounts the story of the Magi who come to visit the new-born baby in Bethlehem. 

Reminders

- While we are still dealing with health challenges: flu, colds, Covid, make use of the hand sanitizer units at the doors of the church; masks can still be worn indoors if you desire; the sign of peace can be shared with a wave or nod of your head if shaking hands is uncomfortable at this time.
