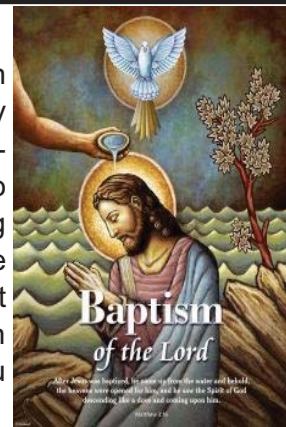

We are in the process of preparing information which will go home via the 4 schools affiliated with the parish once they return to class and we will also post the information on our website. At this time we have not established a firm schedule. The pastoral team is meeting this week to devise a timeline. Most likely we are looking at the end of February/March for Reconciliation and May for Eucharist. We have at-home materials which we will be distributing to families to prepare for these sacraments.

PASTORAL CHANGES

As you read last week, Fr. Daniel has been given a new assignment effective July 5th to take on the task of Pastor of St. Michael's Parish in London. We were blessed to be able to keep him as our Associate Pastor when we became a Family of Parishes 2 years ago because of his other responsibilities as the Episcopal Vicar of Windsor and Essex. That term has ended and now the Bishop has called upon him to become a Pastor and take on an eventual new family of parishes in London.

Bishop Fabbro has assigned Fr. Jim Higgins as the new Associate Pastor of our Family of Parishes effective July 5th. Fr. Angelus and Fr. Barnabas remain with us as Chaplains to St. Anthony of Padua.

Masses are \$10 each (cash is preferable). Pope Francis has established a Year of St. Joseph so that "every member of the faithful, following his example, may strengthen their life of faith daily in the complete fulfillment of God's will."

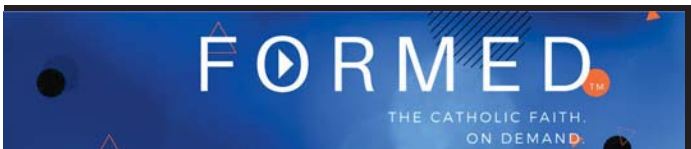
