**BUILDING UPDATE SJV**

We have signed a contract to replace the roof of the parish hall which has failed over the winter. Flat roofs are always an adventure. The work is expected to take a week and is complex due to a variety of issues: HVAC unit needs to be lifted off as well as intricate flashing work. Accent Roofing has been awarded the project which will cost just over \$100,000. Thankfully we have funds on deposit with the Diocesan Loan Fund which will cover the cost. As of press time I am still awaiting the schedule of work.

Masses will be adjusted on Tuesday and Thursday to **6:30 pm**. Access to the building during the day will be restricted in order to provide for a safe and secure work environment. Any funerals that arise will occur over at Our Lady of the Atonement so that the work can be completed with no interruptions.

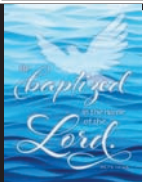
### **CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE NEWS**
