When Jesus gave His final instructions to the apostles, they were not in the form of a “how to, step by step” book. He simply said: go and bring the Good News, baptize, and proclaim the reign of God’s love. It would take each disciple, listening to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, to figure out just exactly how this would be accomplished. This required trust and openness.

The Family of Parishes model that Bishop Fabbro has instituted for our Diocese is a response to the call to be authentic witnesses of the Gospel to our world. With fewer priests to serve, it became clear that things would have to be done differently. This model encourages and challenges us to think bigger and broader. We are to go beyond the boundaries of the known and comfortable and embrace the new and uncertain. It will take time and openness from all of us.

I will be on retreat starting after the mass at the nursing home on Tuesday. Fr. John Comiskey will be here next weekend to celebrate Pentecost with us. The following weekend I will be at St. John Vianney and Fr. Daniel will be here.

Please pray for me and our parish team as we prepare to shepherd this new Family. I am looking forward to the silence of the retreat and the chance to allow the Holy Spirit to guide me in the work that lays ahead.

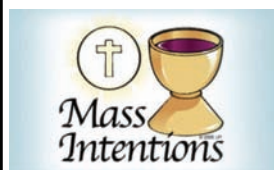

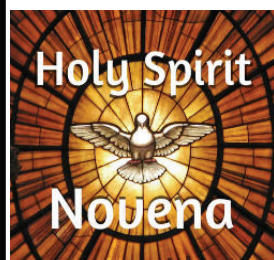
