All other protocols remain in place: physical distancing, wearing of masks, etc.

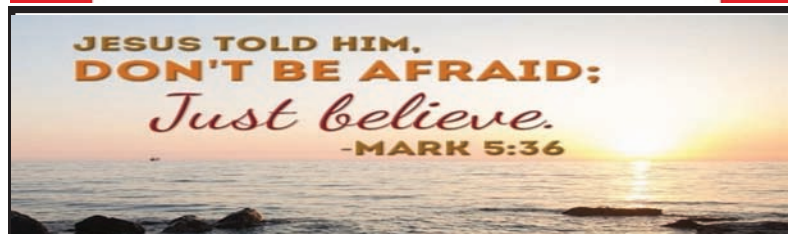

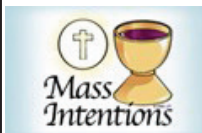
They have scripture studies, lives of the saints, church history, and lots of things for children too. Why not find some time this summer and learn more about our faith?
