Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

A Message from Fr. Rob

As we return to the Season of Ordinary Time, we have two Solemnities to help focus our attention. Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity, next week the Body and Blood of Jesus. Our earliest experience of the Trinity besides being brought into existence through the love of God is on the day of our baptism. Water is poured over our head and we hear the words: "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." From that moment we are transformed and invited into the very life of God.

The Trinity can best be understood as a relationship of love. Jesus often spoke of the love the Father had for Him and this love that they share is the life of the Holy Spirit. Jesus invites us to deepen our relationship with God and seek new ways of coming to know God. Of course we can experience God in the beauty of creation and thank God for this wonderful world we inhabit. We also experience God in the people around us, formed in the image and likeness of God. And we experience God of course as we gather each Sunday around the Lord's table.
