A Message From Fr. Rob....

Today's solemnity is meant to be a reminder to all of us of the importance of the Eucharist. It was instituted in order to invite Catholics to a deeper love for the gift of the Eucharist in their lives. It came at a time when the Eucharist had become routine, ordinary, and often without significance. Sort of like the people of Israel roaming through the desert and forgetting just who it was who liberated them from slavery.

Sometimes we just seem to forget what is essential. Today we are reminded that this gift is what forms us for mission. Nourished by God's Word and the Lord's Body and Blood, we are sustained for the task that has been entrusted to us.

COVID 19 RE-OPENING UPDATE

As you are aware, the Province of Ontario released an updated re-opening schedule last week. It has three phases and is very specific in terms of what opens and when etc. following scientific/medical criteria for % of vaccines administered etc. (see: [news.ontario.ca roadmap](https://news.ontario.ca/roadmap) to reopen)

We continue to perform funerals and baptisms with a 10 person limit. Bishop Fabbro will keep all weekday and weekend masses celebrated privately by the priests until we are able to fully re-open with a higher percentage of capacity. Confessions are available by calling the office to make an appointment.

As things go, we are not sure at this point of the re-opening date. We are in the phase 2 section of the protocols and it will depend on the success of the phase 1 criteria determined by the province.

I know this is frustrating and challenging for everyone. We continue to pray for an end to the pandemic and for healing. We pray for the young couples preparing for marriage, many of whom have had to re-schedule their weddings multiple times. We were ready to celebrate with our children and youth the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation and that has been put on hold. We are working on alternative dates yet again. We no longer put things in pen!

We know many of our elderly in nursing homes and assisted living facilities long for the presence of family members. We pray for a fast rollout of the 2nd shot for as many people as possible so we can achieve the % required and get back together worshipping.

If we hit the metrics required, we will open again to indoor religious gatherings at 15% capacity (Phase 2) to begin with but we will have to wait and see. Let us continue to pray for one another.
