Sunday, March 12, 2023 Third Sunday of Lent

A message from Fr. Rob....

Over the next three weekends our Gospels present three important moments in the ministry of Jesus that shed further light on who He is and what His mission entails for all of us. Today's encounter is meant to get us thinking about our baptism. In the living waters of baptism, we are made new. We enter into a life of grace and begin a relationship with the Lord who desires to know us and to have us know Him.

St. John Paul II often remarked that people should always know the day of their baptism and keep it close in mind and heart because this was a great day of grace. The woman who encounters Jesus today has an opportunity to change her life and start fresh. May we continue our Lenten journey, seeking to draw closer to the Lord.

HOLY WEEK: It is not too soon to start thinking about this important week and the liturgies which each of us is invited to prayerfully attend. As a Family of Parishes, there is great joy in coming together for Holy Thursday and the Easter Vigil, joining around the Lord's Table and renewing our baptismal commitment to follow the Risen Lord.

The pastoral team continues to receive feedback and encourages more from St. John Vianney parishioners about an optimal time for Sunday morning mass. We have been asked to consider moving to a later time which might encourage more people to attend, especially young families.

Covid drastically decreased attendance and participation all around the world and recovery has been slow. There has been an encouraging increase in attendance at 9 am over the last three weeks (just over 200 people). Indeed we have been seeing a rise at all the masses in the Family). There is plenty of room in SJV church to accommodate everyone with two weekend masses and if a slight change in the Sunday time helps to increase participation and involvement, this could be a good thing. We pray for wisdom and understanding as we discern.
