



March 14, 2021 Fourth Sunday of Lent A note from Fr. Rob...



"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing: it is the gift of God." How often might we feel that we are on our own?

How often might we feel that we are on our own? That everything relies on our own strength and power and our own wits? However we are reminded today that we are to rely on God alone. God has already saved us, rescued us, redeemed us and always loves us. Grace is gift. Each day is gift. The good thing about a Lenten journey is that each day is a new opportunity to grow in holiness. We put the past behind us and move forward. Today is called Laetare Sunday-Rejoicing Sunday. The joy of the Resurrection is getting closer. We still need to carry the Cross and endure the Passion but it ends with new life.

Please check out the Holy Week Schedule and the times and locations of these important celebrations. We are trying our best to provide opportunities to gather with the restrictions in place while at the same time bring our Family of Parishes together for two of the liturgies of Holy Week: Holy Thursday (which will be at Our Lady of the Atonement) and the Easter Vigil (which will be at St. John Vianney) as a sign of unity. Reservations for the Holy Week liturgies can be made Monday-Wednesday of Holy Week: March 29-31. Note the additional masses on Easter Sunday. Wisdom from the Saints: "Virtues are formed by prayer. 

EASTER TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum (3 days) is when we celebrate the suffering, death and Resurrection of our Lord. It is the high point of the Church's liturgical year. As a family of parishes, it is important to celebrate well with devotion these special days and to do so together as one praying assembly where possible.

HOLY THURSDAY - April 1st - 7 pm @ Our Lady of the Atonement for the Family of Parishes Tonight we recall the Lord's Last Supper and the Institution of the Eucharist. The emphasis is on love and service (John 13:1-5) imitating the example of Jesus who washed the feet of his disciples.
