Third Sunday of Lent

From the desk of Fr. Rob.....

Today begins the first of 3 very long but very important Gospel readings. For those journeying to the Easter Sacraments, they are essential. For all of us, they hold special meaning to help us prepare to renew our baptismal promises. Each of these gospel passages provide encounters of grace and give us a deeper understanding of Jesus and the mission the Father entrusted to His care.

Today's passage invites us to see Jesus as the one who can bring us to the waters of eternal life. He assures the Samaritan woman that this life-giving water is available-all she need do is ask for it. Jesus invites her (and us) to trust in the promise of eternal life and God's abundant mercy.

SHARE LENT: today's insert is a Lenten reflection from Development and Peace. We are called to be in solidarity with our sisters and brothers in the developing nations. This means learning about their situation and some of their daily challenges.

The annual collection for Share Lent will be taken up on Solidarity Sunday March 28/29 as well as at the Holy Thursday mass. 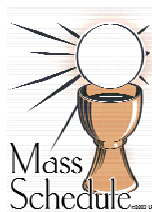

Following mass, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until 12 noon, finishing with Benediction. There will also be time for receiving the sacrament of reconciliation.

St. Joseph is the principal patron of the Universal Church and the Church in Canada. Come and spend some time in silent prayer before the Lord. What a great blessing during these Lenten days. Think of it as a little mini prayer morning.

We will offer a similar experience on Wednesday, March 25th, the Solemnity of the Assumption.



The Mura: beset by buffalos, plagued by potash

For several years now, the Mura people of Brazil's Amazonas state have sought to assert their claim to their ancestral lands. To their frustration however, it has been much easier for cattle herders and a potash mine to occupy and control those lands than it has been for them to have their rights respected. Development and Peace's partner, the Indigenous Missionary Council (CIMI), helps them advocate for, defend and publicize their cause more effectively.
