Sunday, March 24, 2024 Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

"Christ became obedient for us to death, even death on a cross. Therefore God exalted him and gave him the name above every name." (Philippians 2:8-9) Our week begins with the understanding that Jesus embraces the Cross willingly for our salvation. He is obedient to His Father's will and makes this journey to death and resurrection. We are invited to journey along with Him. This week is meant to be a time of prayer, silence, meditation. See what can be put aside in order to focus on the Lord's Passion. Invite the Lord to be your strength so that each of us can carry the cross with Him. It is always humbling for us on Good Friday as we process silently and reverently to venerate the Cross together.

Holy Thursday reminds us of the gift of the Eucharist and how this gift involves the call to serve our sisters and brothers. The Easter Vigil will find us reflecting on God's loving presence throughout salvation history and the promise of new life that comes to us in baptism. We will welcome new members into the church through the sacraments of initiation. And of course Easter Sunday will be our day of joy as we announce the Risen Lord and the new life that is ours. Plan to come and pray together these special liturgies of Holy Week and allow the Lord's grace to fill us.


