# March 3, 2019– Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

It has been a very long time since we have heard these scriptures proclaimed. Perhaps too long! The Gospel lays out a very explicit challenge for all of us. We often find it too easy to offer up judgement on a neighbour, family member co-worker or friend. We forget the words of the Gospel last week: Do not judge and you will not be judged. Today's Gospel warns us of seeking to condemn others for their seemingly miniscule faults while neglecting to deal with the large faults and failings of our own lives.

As we prepare for the Season of Lent, we are given an opportunity to spend 40 days bettering ourselves and worrying less about the faults of others. At the end of the day, we are responsible for ourselves and our own spiritual growth. We need to be aware of our own need for grace and redemption and be less concerned with correcting our neighbour.

Join us Ash Wednesday for mass as we begin our Lenten journey. We have mass with the 2 schools at 9:30 am and then also at 7 pm. Be sure to keep handy our Lenten works of mercy schedule as we seek to reach out to others. There are prayer materials at the doors of the church and we welcome all to join us on Tuesdays and Wednesdays before mass beginning next week for our DVD series on conversion.
