Sunday, May 29, 2022– Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Today's celebration marks 40 days of the Risen Lord being present to His disciples. His appearances in a glorified body showed the disciples that He had conquered death and was truly alive. As we have listened to the stories of the early church community in the Acts of the Apostles, we see how their belief in the Risen Lord allowed them to be transformed. They became bold witnesses of the Gospel and sought ways to preach the Good News wherever they could and to whomever would listen to them.

Today we are reminded that strengthened by the Risen Lord, we are all commissioned to be His witnesses to the whole world. As we prepare for Pentecost next weekend, let us open our hearts to receive this gift and embrace our call to be missionary disciples. Wear red in honour of this special solemnity next weekend!

Each week we find ourselves resuming the pace of parish life. We will resume celebrating the sacrament of baptism within our Sunday liturgies next weekend which is always a sign of hope and new life. We pray with these families as they bring their child to the font so as to receive the gift of faith.

This Tuesday evening we will celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) with a large group of children of catechetical age as well as some of the youth who were unable to attend confirmation in February. Let us keep them in our prayers.
