As we prepare for the end of the Liturgical Year, our readings take on an apocalyptic tone. We are reminded to be ready, stay vigilant, stay awake, keep alert etc. I suppose this is because we may all have the tendency time to time to do the opposite. It is so easy to get distracted from the work of the Kingdom and to be lulled into a sense of routine and complacency. St. Paul reminds us of our final destination which is heaven. 


During the month of November, we fondly remember in prayer all of our deceased loved ones who have gone before us as well as the parishioners who have died since last November.


Let us continue to pray for the members of our Society of St. Vincent De Paul who serve the poor in our area with great kindness and dedication.

LITURGY UPDATE: We had a great meeting with our lectors and ministers of holy communion. We will be doing some parish wide education soon on some liturgical items and our eucharistic practice as we prepare to re-instate communion from the cup in January.

- if you require communion brought to you in church due to mobility issues, please let an usher know when you arrive so they know where you are sitting. One Min. of Communion (choir side minister) is assigned to bring communion when they finish their section guided by the usher.
- for those bringing communion home to the sick, when you approach the minister in the communion line, be sure to receive communion yourself first and then present the pyx to the minister and tell them how many are needed.
- Remember the uniform posture of the assembly is to stand once the celebrant has received communion and to remain standing until all have received in the communion line. Once communion has been received by the assembly, you are invited to sit or kneel. We do not wait for the Eucharist to be returned to the tabernacle. This is a separate act from the communion procession and does not require us to remain standing.
