Sunday, November 13, 2022 Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time A message from Fr. Rob....

Jesus tells us in the Gospel that we will face uncertain times throughout the course of our discipleship. There will be all kinds of unease, struggle, challenging situations that will cause us some worry and even fear. Jesus tells us to hold firm and not to be afraid. As disciples we are called not only to have hope but to be witnesses of hope. People must see in us a firm trust and confidence in God's abiding presence in our hearts. St. Paul reminds us that we must be about the work of the Kingdom, answering the call each day to bring Jesus to others.

Today is the World Day of the Poor. Pope Francis, in instituting this day just before the end of the liturgical year is inviting us to once again see our connectedness to one another, especially with the poor and suffering. We recognize the heroic efforts of our 3 conferences of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul who respond to the needs of many within our area with great compassion and understanding. Your support of them all year long is greatly appreciated as they seek to serve those in need. This day serves as a reminder of the common bonds of humanity. The world often seems so divided into so many different categories. This day of prayer and awareness reminds us that those categories are not more important than the common dignity we share as the children of God.


After mass: reception to follow in the Atonement Family Centre hosted jointly by the members of the SJV and OLA Catholic Women's League.
