WORLD DAY OF THE POOR: As a result of the Year of Mercy, Pope Francis instituted this annual day to remind all disciples of the universal call to assist the poor. Make sure your name and address are on the envelope to ensure proper credit for a tax receipt at the end of the year from the Society. Make cheques payable to the respective St. Vincent de Paul Society Conference.
