From the desk of Fr. Daniel......

This past Monday, Remembrance Day, I attended a prayer service held at one of the schools we serve. All the students, teachers and staff were present in the gym for the service. I was very impressed by the reverence and prayerfulness of the students and all in attendance.

We experienced our first real snow fall this past Monday as well. Were you ready? As we come to the end of yet another liturgical year with the celebration of Christ the King next weekend, the Church reflects on the last things: Death, Judgement, Heaven, Hell and the end of time. Are you ready? This past liturgical year we have been listening to St. Luke's Gospel. This Gospel reflects on the gentleness and forgiveness that were the marks of Jesus' ministry. Once again this weekend, the Gospel gives an account of the teaching given by Jesus in Jerusalem before His passion. The readings this weekend challenge us to look at our own lives. Where do we place our time, resources and hope? Is God calling us to create more space for service, prayer, love and community? These are the things in life that are enduring.

What good is the Gospel of Jesus Christ if we do not engage in the world we live in? The fruit of prayer is strong faith and it is faith that leads us to Christian action. Prayer without action and involvement is a futile act. Yes, the Holy Spirit calls us to be bold, courageous, active and compassionate. We are called to be a people of prayer, we are called to action and that is what it means to be a missionary church. Every one of us is called to be a missionary disciple. Together, let us be faithful to the teachings of Jesus. We are to welcome His gift of wisdom, to continue looking first and foremost to God in every graced moment. And then, to roll with the punches and all that life throws at us, the joys, the pains and the disappointments, until He comes again to take us home.




