A Message from Fr. Rob

Jesus tells the parables of the talents in today's Gospel. Our common understanding is that all of us have been entrusted with the treasures of the Kingdom. The expectation of Jesus for His disciples is that we are going to do something with what we have been given. Jesus does not say you must do big things with the things I give you. Instead He says you must do "something" with what you have received.

There is something comforting in that. Instead of feeling overwhelmed by the state of the world and the many needs that confront us, we can choose to do something even if it may seem small and ordinary. After all, St. Therese of Lisieux in her Little Way simply determined that God's plan for her was to do "everything with love". Good advice.

On this World Day of the Poor, flowing from the Year of Mercy in 2015, Pope Francis is highlighting our call to respond to the needs of those suffering in poverty. The church has always had a responsibility to care for the poor: those poor materially and those poor in spiritual ways.


