Solemnity of Christ the King November 21, 2021 A Message From Fr. Jim....



Today we celebrate the last Sunday in the Church year. Next Sunday with Advent we start a new Church year. This might be a good time to create an Advent Wreath. What you will need is some greenery to form a circle and four candles (traditionally three purple and one pink). You can find Advent prayers

for each week on Google.

Understanding today's feast of Christ the King may be particularly challenging. While most of us do not have direct experience with kings or royalty, we have a sense of who they are. We know that royalty have sovereignty over their kingdoms. We know that those who are subjects to royalty offer them allegiance and honor. To understand how Christ is our king, we extend and magnify what we know to be true of the best of human royalty. Christ's kingship extends to all places, all people, and all times. Christ manifests his kingship through his death on the cross in which he offered salvation to everyone. Those who can see with eyes of faith recognize Jesus to be our heavenly king.

This past week I received word that one of our priests died in a car accident. His name was Father Matt George and he was only 52 years old. He was truly a gifted man and worked tirelessly for Right to Life. Matt had in the last few years battled with cancer and he was always positive about the struggles he faced. He was an inspiration to many of us. With his passing I am encouraging our young men to consider the vocation to be a priest. We come in all different sizes and backgrounds. The one thing that we have in common is the desire to serve the People of God and serve as a bridge to their relationship with God. Please pray that we will experience an increase of vocations to the Priesthood.

Music gladdens the heart. I am so appreciative of our musicians and cantors for gifting us with music. You are welcome to join in singing (while keeping your mask in place). However, we will not be replacing the hymnals until sometime in the New Year. So if you know the hymn please join in. Starting next weekend, with the beginning of Advent, we will sing the parts of the Mass.

affiliated parish schools: Langlois, Desmarais, Lassaline and St. John Vianney. Parents with kids in other schools are asked to contact Maria directly.


