November 22, 2020 Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

From the desk of Fr. Rob......

Our liturgical year comes to an end this week with the celebration of this special solemnity. Matthew's Gospel presents an image of the Last Judgement. Jesus tells us that at the end of the age, our Heavenly Father will gather all of us around the throne of mercy and grace and humanity will be judged. The criteria: how we treated one another as neighbours. Did we respond to those in need or did we turn our faces away from them? This Gospel really gives us plenty of material for prayer and reflection. Discipleship is really about concrete actions of service in love. Each day the Lord sends us many opportunities where we can joyfully witness to being a disciple of Christ, even in the smallest of tasks.

Next weekend we begin the **Season of Advent.** These four weeks are meant to be a time of prayerful anticipation and reflection on the Lord's coming. Perhaps with the call for all of us to remain vigilant and keep one another safe, these weeks will take on more significance as the normal hustle and bustle of life during this time of year will be a lot different. Perhaps we will find the necessary time to pray, be silent and watchful. Come Lord Jesus, Come!

Please note: This is separate from the regular Saturday/Sunday registration which is Tuesday-Thursday, 10 am-3 pm. We don't want to get the registrations all mixed up – there are a lot of masses to keep track of as you can imagine. Having these dedicated evenings to take the Christmas calls will help us keep things organized.

We are also be getting the word out via facebook, the schools etc. for those who perhaps have not been to mass since COVID and are uncertain of the mass protocols, the need to call in etc. and who may be wanting to attend Christmas mass.
