## November 24, 2019 Solemnity of Christ the King From the desk of Fr. Daniel......

Jesus said . . . "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in Paradise." Luke 23:43

Today is the Last Sunday in Ordinary Time. On this final Sunday, the Church presents us with the image of the Crucified One as King. The official name for this Sunday is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King of the Universe. To many people, the idea is simply ridiculous: is it not on the Cross that Jesus experiences His greatest weakness and vulnerability? And yet there has always been an instinct in the Church that speaks of Christ as "the one who reigns from the Tree," and many early Christian depictions of the crucifixion do not show the sagging, dead body of Jesus (that we are most familiar with from our crucifixes), but Christ robed as a priest and king, alive and majestic, not a victim but a victor, in control and exercising His royal authority even from the Cross. The Gospel today does not speak of Jesus in his kingly robes, rather, he is depicted as one beaten and bruised. His bloodied body nailed to a rough hewn cross. The only indication that He is king is the sign attached to the same cross over His head. Take a moment and look at your crucifix at home. The sign reads in short form: I.N.I.R., Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum - Jesus of Nazareth King of the Jews. Unexpectedly it is the thief who recognized Jesus as the Christ, the Anointed One, the Messiah.

"Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Luke 23:42

Preparation classes will take place at both St John Vianney site on a Wednesday evening & Our Lady of the Atonement site on a Thursday evening .


There will be a parent meeting in January to get all the details.
