### November 4, 2018-31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

We are approaching the end of the liturgical year which concludes with the Solemnity of Christ the King. Our readings remind us over these weeks that life is fast and fragile and thus we must put our time and energy into what is essential to share in the Kingdom: following the commandments of God and looking to the example of Jesus. We are invited to reflect on what a life of holiness entails: using the commandments to help us live at peace with God, ourselves and one another. Moses exhorts the people to remember what God has done for them and continues to do for them each day. When we wake up, we should start each day in the same way, remembering God's goodness.

I had the opportunity to take a four day jaunt over to Portugal while in Ireland (only a 2.5 hour flight away). My friend wanted a change of scenery after living in Dublin a year. We prayed at the birthplace of St. Anthony in Lisbon. He was a great preacher and witness to holiness. We also spent a day in Fatima which I found to be very moving. There I witnessed the profound faith of so many people, coming to seek the Blessed Mother's intercession and embracing her invitation to seek the path of holiness through daily prayer. Pray the Rosary daily or part of it. It is a wonderful prayer tool which helps us to grow spiritually.


### NURSING HOME MINISTRY


