St. Paul, as he writes to the Thessalonians lays out a good description of missionary discipleship. 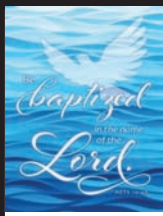
Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace.

All volunteers are welcome, however any student under the age of 18 will need to be accompanied by an adult from one of the two parishes.

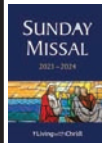
