A Message from Fr. Rob

Our readings today are an invitation for us to rejoice in Today Jesus invites his disciples and all of us to consider what is the bedrock foundation of our spiritual life. In answer to the question from the lawyer, Jesus answers that the greatest commandment is the call to love God with everything that we have: mind, body, strength and to love our neighbours as ourselves. He was simply reminding the crowd of what they had already committed to as a child of God. It was a gentle yet forceful reminder that each day we show our love of God by the way we love one another.

Our world is deeply troubled and it is easy to get discouraged by war, conflict, civil unrest, poverty, the nasty tone that seems to creep into conversation and the public sphere thanks to the endless ability to tweet and text to our mind's delight. What we have forgotten is the sense of mutual respect we owe to one another and the reverence we are to have for God. Being a godly, upright person is not impossible, just challenging. Jesus is there to help us walk the path of holiness.

ALL SOULS REMEMBRANCE

The month of November begins with two important celebrations: **All Saints (Nov. 1)**

and **All Souls (Nov 2)**. All Saints celebrates all those holy men and women, known and unknown, who now share around the throne of grace in the Kingdom and whom the Church acknowledges as saints. They pray for us and encourage us on our journey.

All Souls is a remembrance of those who have gone before us and await the fullness of the Resurrection to new life. This day reminds us that through the Risen Lord, we have the promise of eternal life with the Father. Jesus has conquered death.

During the month of November, we fondly remember in prayer all of our deceased loved ones who have gone before us as well as the parishioners who have died since last November.
