The readings this weekend challenge us on how to be loving members of a community, a family, a group, indeed the human race. Relationships are always challenging and there will always be conflict and misunderstandings between people. The key comes from our second reading as how to best navigate these relationships: "owe no one anything, except to love one another." There will always be disagreements among people. However if we can keep love at the centre, then things don't have to end up in rancour, nastiness or unpleasantness. The key is to communicate honestly and lovingly. The internet, while a great tool has also allowed the tone of civic discourse to plummet, where everyone feels they can say whatever they want unfiltered and harshly, often hiding behind anonymity. This is not the way that Jesus puts forward.

Today is our monthly Holy Hour for Vocations, 2-3 pm at St. John Vianney Church. Come and spend some time before the Lord, praying that across our Diocese young people will open their hearts to hear God's call and start to discern their proper vocation.

Next weekend after all masses we will host socials as a way to engage with one another and build up community. We will also have a chance to consider getting involved in one of the many ministry opportunities we have in our family. Everyone has something to offer in order to build up our faith family. Please pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance in seeing what gifts you have to offer in ministry.

GRIEFSHARE


