Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the desk of Fr. Rob.....

Our readings again this week bring up the theme of forgiveness. In this challenging Gospel parable, Jesus speaks of the hardness of heart that can arise in a person who is unwilling to forgive another, even though they themselves have been forgiven. How soon we forget! The author of the Book of Sirach is even more direct- "anger and wrath, these are abominations, yet a sinner holds on to them." Being part of a community, a family, a workplace, a classroom means that there will be many opportunities where the need to forgive or to ask for forgiveness will arise. Let us pray always for an understanding heart, patience and generosity towards one another, especially those who have wronged us.
