Sunday, September 24, 2023 Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time A Message from Fr. Rob

How appropriate and timely that our Gospel this weekend is about the landowner searching for workers to assist in the vineyard. Each time the landowner sets out, it is with the intention of obtaining the workers required to get the harvest collected. He finds people willing to work and promptly sends them on their way to the fields. At the end of the day, the landowner rewards all the workers with the same wage. We must remember that the parables of Jesus are all about God the Father and the Kingdom. Rather than get caught up in the nitty gritty of labour relations and fair wages etc, we are instead to look deeper. The Father requires workers in the Kingdom. He never tires of going out and looking for those who might be open to an invitation to go and work in the vineyard. And when the day is done, God rewards each of the workers with the same wage: eternal life. Simply put, our work in the Kingdom is all about what comes next for us: eternal life in the presence of God forever.

Last weekend we had an opportunity to answer God's call and step forward in service. The Holy Spirit indeed moved hearts to respond to our appeal to get involved. We are in the process of collating the information and getting it to those who lead the various ministries so that they can contact the new ministers soon in order to get the ball rolling, especially those areas that require obtaining a police clearance form. 17th Bishop's Dinner for Windsor/Essex


After a hiatus of three years, the Windsor/Essex Bishop's Dinner returns to the Ciocaro Club, on October 26, 2023! You are cordially invited to
