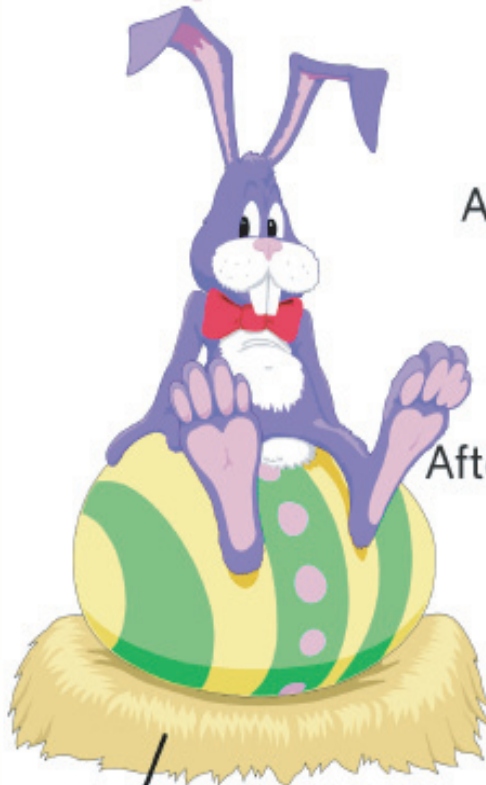

"Why is one eating or drinking? Gluttony is indiscriminate eating or drinking. Fasting is eating mindfully with full attention. Notice, first there's the food thought, then the thought about the time to eat the food, then about the quantity. Now the training, called fasting is to check those four decisions: eating, the kind of food, when, and how much. So fasting provides some helps about what food I should eat, how expensive and available they are, when the appropriate time is and how much I should eat or drink. Fasting is not always a negative thing. In reality it's a middle way."
