PASTOR'S PEN

Dear parishioners;

It is my wish and prayer that all of you had a blessed and joyful Easter. The Gospel readings on the days immediately following Easter continue to tell the Easter story - Mary Magdalene meeting Jesus outside the tomb, the disciples on the road to Emmaus, the appearance in the upper room to all the disciples, this Sunday's story of doubting Thomas. Each story gives a different aspect of the Resurrection message. Mary, ever faithful, even before the Romans at the crucifixion, becomes the 'apostle' to the apostles, the first to announce a visitation with the risen Christ. The disciples at Emmaus discover the presence of Christ in the breaking of the bread, forerunners of all who come together in his name at Eucharist. Thomas' encounter with the risen Lord compelled him to make the greatest profession of faith when he said "my Lord and my God".

At the same time we are reading the Resurrection accounts we begin seeing the story of the Church's birth and growth. Christ is now alive in his disciples and the kingdom is growing, coming to fulfillment, liturgically in the Feast of the Pentecost. We are the inheritors of the apostles and the new disciples, the story continues in us. As we experience the risen Christ in Word and Sacrament, let us be faithful witnesses joyfully proclaiming the resurrection of our risen Lord and Savior as the apostles did.

Christ is risen indeed. Alleluia.
