Occasionally the words of Jesus seem to smack us in the face. We shake our heads and move on to something more comforting. Such are the words in today's gospel. Most of us do not want to imagine the possibility of strife and animosity in our family.

Nonetheless, Jesus knew that sometimes families are a hindrance for disciples. In his day, family was often the one structure protecting individuals – but at the cost of a patriarchal system demanding conformity and obedience to authoritarian demands.

In our day, I have seen parents oppose a possible vocation for one of their children, or react negatively when a son or daughter wishes to spend a year working for and with the poor in another country. We also know the pain of parents whose children distance themselves from the faith, despite a good education and faithfilled upbringing.

Choosing the Way of Jesus has never been easy. That is no different today. What Jesus asks of us, however, is that we focus our attention on the true kingdom, that of our Father in heaven, where all are brothers and sisters, especially those most in need. When we work to build God's kingdom, our earthly families can follow along – or go their own way. As painful as that may be for the disciple, the Way is what Jesus demands.
