Do you remember the time you volunteered at the big parish fundraiser? You threw yourself into the work, sacrificing an enormous amount of your free time, donating generously to help the parish make it a great success. At the parish thank-you dinner, you expected to be seated at the head table but weren't. You expected that your efforts would be recognized.

How then should we act? What should be our attitude? Today's first reading and the passage from the Gospel of Luke offer guidance. They speak of the humility we need as Christians, because, as Sirach says, it is only when we are humble that we are truly exalted. Through our humility the Lord is truly glorified.

Our humility grows from the authenticity of our love and our concern for others. Jesus says everyone who "exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted." Our proximity to the 'head table' in our lives is linked to our invitation to the poor into our lives. Pope Francis reminds us we must not place ourselves above others but step down to serve them, especially the poor and vulnerable. As he wrote on Twitter, "To live charitably means not looking out for our own interests, but carrying the burdens of the weakest and poorest among us."
