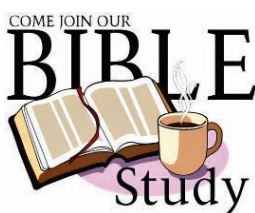
## Children's Liturgy Program

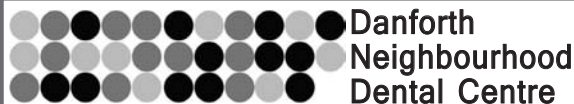
