The Gospel reading today from Matthew includes several jarring phrases: "An eye for an eye" and "Love your neighbor and hate your enemy." Rather than measuring and limiting our response to another's need, He is telling us to be generous and "go the extra mile." That's hard to do; but, in the end, it's the ultimate challenge, namely, to not hate those who oppose us, to not hate our enemies, to continue to have gracious and forgiving hearts in the face of opposition and hatred.

In the knowledge that we are temples of God and bearers of God's Spirit within us, we find the courage and the perseverance to embrace wholeheartedly the command to love our neighbor as ourselves. Finally, lest we become discouraged and fall short in our efforts, let us remember that this is the work of a lifetime.
